## GETTING STARTED with Banner 7x: Oracle JInitiator Installation from Windows XP

**Introduction:** To launch Banner 7x on any PC, it is necessary to download the ActiveX control 'Oracle JInitiator'. This is a one-time install per desktop with instructions that vary depending on your operation system (Windows or Windows XP). If prompted to load ActiveX control, follow the steps below to complete the installation.

#### Step 1: Verify Operating System

- Click start from main toolbar
- Right click My Computer
- Click Properties
- Click General tab




### Step 2: Launch Banner

- Click Information Bar: the prompt to Install ActiveX control B




#### Step 3: Install ActiveX control Oracle JInitiator


