<b>E-Web</b> Online Services	<b>E-Web</b> is used primarily by faculty, advisors and students, with limited staff access.	<b>E-Web</b> is accessed using your Eastern ID number and a Web PIN via an internet browser such as IE. A link to <b>E-Web</b> can be found on the Eastern homepage "E-Web Online Services" or accessed directly at <a href="http://eweb.easternct.edu">http://eweb.easternct.edu</a> . <b>E-Web</b> can be accessed from both on and off campus.	<b>E-Web</b> is used by faculty to enter grades, to review teaching assignments, class rosters, advisee lists, student transcripts, degree evaluations, and other student information. Students access <b>E-Web</b> to register for classes, review their class schedule, advisor assignment, unofficial transcripts, grades, registration appointment, financial aid, credit card payments etc.. <b>E-Web</b> is considered a self-service tool. Although Faculty can view student information on all students, Faculty can only view their own class information	The <u>only</u> changes to <b>E-Web</b> during the Banner 7 migration were an overall change in appearance and the addition of advisor type (primary, secondary, previous) to the advisee listing.
<b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b>	<b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> is used by many Faculty, department secretaris and administrative offices staff.	<b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> is accessed via the ECSU Banner Reporting icon on the desktop or through the Windows "Start" button. <b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> currently only works on campus on a PC. A pilot is underway for a web-based version that will be referred to as eREPORTS. At present eREPORTS cannot be accessed outside the University firewall.	<b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> is used to produce "canned" parameter driven reports such as class rosters, faculty schedules, student extracts, labels, schedule reports, section tally reports, major reports, etc.. All reports found on the <b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> menus have been developed at the request of University faculty and staff. A process exists for requesting the development and addition of new or revised reports to the repository.	<b>ECSU Banner Reporting</b> was <u>not</u> impacted by the Banner 7 migration. Everything works the same way as it did before.
<b>eBANNER</b> (previously Banner 2000 Production)	<b>eBANNER</b> is used primarily by department secretaries and administrative offices, e.g. Registrar's Office, Bursar, Financial Aid, Fiscal Affairs, Residential Life, etc..	<b>eBANNER</b> can only be accessed by individuals who have completed a Banner Account Request form and have been provided with a Banner username and password ( <b>not</b> Eastern ID/Web PIN). <b>eBANNER</b> is accessed via an internet browser such as IE. <b>eBANNER</b> can be accessed from the "Banner" link under the ECSU Services drop down menu on the Eastern homepage or by typing ebanner in the browser address line or at <a href="http://ebanner.easternct.edu">http://ebanner.easternct.edu</a> . At present the University firewall has not been opened to allow off campus access to ebanner.	<b>eBANNER</b> is the heart of the trio of tools. It is the tool used by the administrative offices to enter and maintain, course catalog, schedules, faculty, student, financial aid, student accounts recievable, financial, alumni and institutional advancement data. <b>eBANNER</b> is both more robust and more complex to us then either of the other two tools.	<b>eBANNER</b> is by far the biggest change as a result of the Banner 7 Migration. The tool has transitioned from being a client/server application to be web-based. The overall look and feel of the user interface has changed along with various functional enhancements. Bundled with these changes were changes to hardware as well as the underlying software used to develop the tool.
